





- Rooms typically cost between **\$6,000-\$8,000**, including cash donations and in-kind goods and services.

OUR MISSION

Special Spaces is a non-profit organization that creates dream bedroom makeovers for dependent children, ages 2-19, with cancer who are within one year of active treatment.

Founded in 2004, the organization is headquartered in Knoxville, TN. The founder was inspired to make more dreams come true after volunteering with a local wish-granting organization to makeover a room.

Children are nominated by relatives, medical professionals, or other non-profits and, if eligible, can apply for the makeover. Once applications are reviewed and approved by a national committee, there is a final interview with the applicant. After the interview is completed, the application is granted final approval and the work begins!

OUR WHY

It is estimated that nearly 20,000 children per year are diagnosed with cancer. When that diagnosis is given, it can change their world. The activities they used to enjoy may look and feel different. They may not be able to do the things they really love. Special Spaces gives a child with cancer a unique bedroom to find comfort, joy, and a place to just be a kid!

Driven by the child's imagination and at no cost to the family, Special Spaces works with a team of dedicated volunteers and skilled contractors to transform the child's existing bedroom in just one day. Whether it's princess pretty, superhero strong, or a teen retreat, we work together to make the child's vision a reality.
